- **Light refreshments available for purchase.**

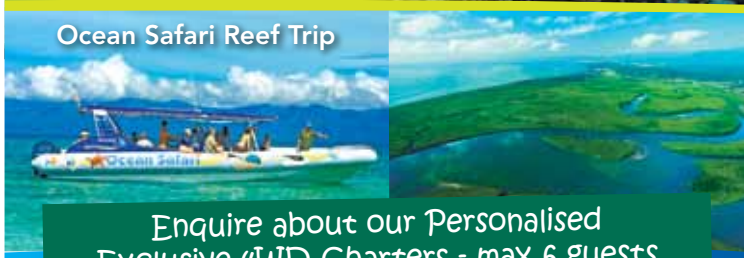

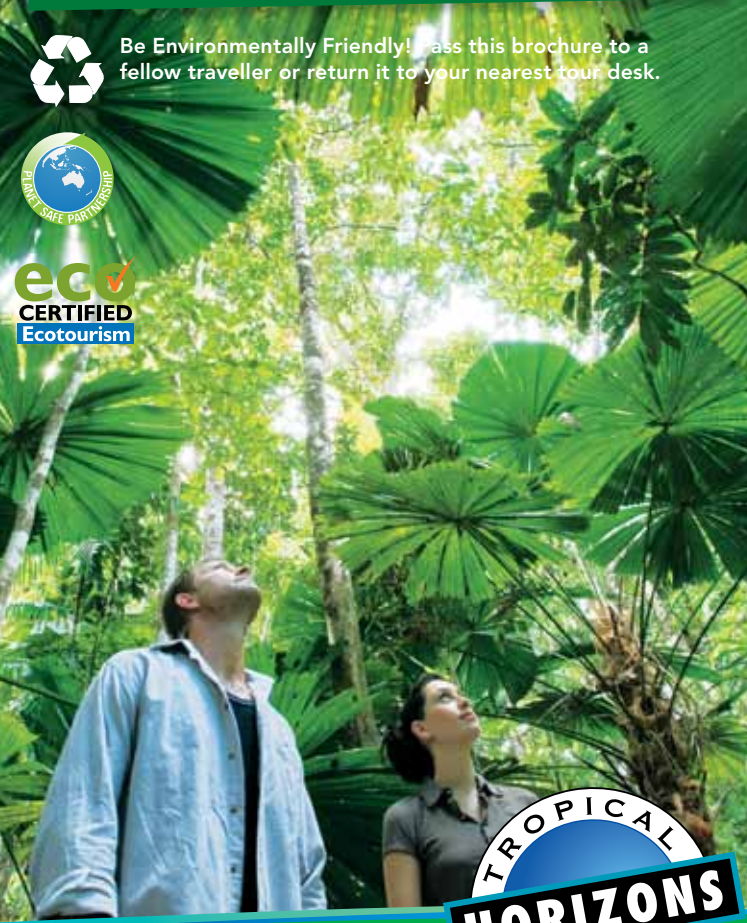

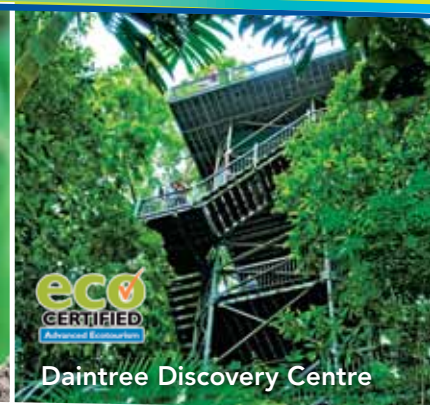

Your Tour: Experience our accredited *Eco-Certified* Tour to unique Cape Tribulation and the Daintree World Heritage listed rainforest, which boasts unique and beautiful flora and fauna. The tour includes an early morning guided walk of Mossman Gorge (available on this tour only until late 2011), in the quieter morning environment, where you will experience this ancient rainforest firsthand, or instead (subject to river volume) enjoy a refreshing swim. Your expert guides will interpret the gorge and walk with you to give you a better understanding of the unique tropical wonderland.

Your tour continues north through sugarcane and the giant Great Dividing Range until we arrive at the mighty Daintree River. There you will catch a river boat and be guided down the Daintree River where there's a strong chance of catching a glimpse of a lazy crocodile or two or tree snake. Journey further north over the Daintree River into the mysterious and awesome Daintree National Park – Cape Tribulation area. Your expert guides will provide you with insightful knowledge of the history of the area and the stunning beauty. View the soaring mountains of Mt Sorrow and Mt

Disappointment, and finally where the rainforest meets the reef at the Kulki Lookout. All the time gathering a full interpretation of this rainforest/beach World Heritage area. Enjoy a lunch in a rainforest setting and take time to refresh with a swimming opportunity. Your final tour attraction is the Daintree Discovery Centre. This magnificent aerial walkway enables you to view the rainforest canopy from all levels. There is a good chance you may spot a wild cassowary here! Enjoy your afternoon tea in the rainforest, before crossing the Daintree River by cable ferry and returning to your accommodation.

Alternatively, if you have the time, stay overnight in the rainforest with one of our packages and experience the real magic of Cape Tribulation. This is a unique experience for the unrushed traveler. Rejoin your tour the next day and return to either Port Douglas or Cairns.
